**The first five Bolivians will be embarking on their Emmaus Walk on August 20-23 in the La Resurrección Emmaus Community in Orlando, Florida.**

After communicating with Rev. Victor Perez, the Regional Director for Emmaus in the Caribbean and Latin America, he has requested letters of agape for these gentlemen. He said, "We would appreciate it if agape letters for our five Bolivian men be sent to Mrs. Rosa Carrion, who is a board member of La Resurrección

Emmaus Community in Florida. Rosa will receive your letters at her email address, will print them and place them in an envelope with the pilgrim's name. Please make sure you identify the letters with the pilgrim's name. If the letters are to be sent in English and you want them translated into Spanish, Rosa will be glad to do it but whomever writes the letter needs to authorize her to do the translation as this is a personal letter to a pilgrim."

In the email itself (not the attachment), simply say:

"I authorize Rosa Carrion to translate my agape letter into Spanish for \_\_\_\_\_."

As well, they might appreciate knowing that there are those here in the States who are praying for them and who have been very much a part of sending them on their Walk.

*Interestingly enough, Rev. Perez will be one of the spiritual directors on the weekend. So, he will convey our best to these “pilgrims from south of the border.” Victor also, by the way, pastors a Spanish-speaking church in Nashville, Tennessee.*
